# Diners, Lena's contribute \$520 to Steuwe's breast cancer walk

Lena's Italian Restaurant's Stefano Zanger knew that the kitchen might be a little busier when people found out that 15 percent the restaurant's sales from June 29 would be donated to Kathy Steuwe's three-day, 60-mile walk for breast cancer. But he was surprised by the response.

"All day long, our phones were ringing and the dining room was busy. And a lot of people who called wanted to be sure their orders went to Kathy's walk," said Zanger. "I want to assure everyone that 15 percent of every dine-in, delivery and take-out order

counted."

When all was said and done, Lena's presented Steuwe with a check for \$520, which represented 15 percent of the day's sales, plus a \$100 bonus at the urging of Momma Lena.

It got so busy at one point that Zanger didn't know if the kitchen could keep up. After former employee Jake Graf finished eating in the dining room, he volunteered to help out the busy kitchen staff.

"I don't know if we'd have made it without him," Zanger said.

Steuwe said she was gratified with Lena's donation and praised the staff.

"It was busy, but the staff was friendly and fast and kept everyone

happy," she said.

Steuwe is participating the Breast Cancer 3-Day, Aug. 14-16. She and thousands of other men and women will walk a 60-mile course to raise money for breast cancer research, education, screening and treatment, through the Susan G. Komen for the Cure and the National Philanthropic Trust Breast Cancer Fund.

Steuwe has agreed to raise \$2,300. But she has a goal of \$3,500.
